



The Kurt Masur Academy

... has, since the 2017/18 season, been offering young, talented musicians from Germany and abroad the chance to prepare themselves for a future career by working with a top orchestra, rich with tradition.

Many graduates from our first years have already earned positions with renowned orchestras. The recipe for success: academy members are integrated intensively into rehearsals and concerts of the Dresden Philharmonic. Through this, they learn to recognize the special culture of performance and the ideal sound of a top orchestra, they work together with international conductors and they form relationships with colleagues. All the while, they pursue practice-oriented studies at the Hochschule für Musik Carl Maria von Weber Dresden.



THE PROGRAM

Duration: 2 years

Type of compensation: training allowance

Course of instruction:

- → Participation in the Dresden Philharmonic's rehearsals, concerts, tours and CD productions, as well as chamber music and outreach projects, with up to 16 orchestral practice sessions per month
- → Individual mentoring from musicians of the Dresden Philharmonic
- → Chamber music coaching and participation in their own Kurt Masur Academy chamber concerts
- → Audition training, mental coaching, study coachings, workshops in music outreach, and more

THE STUDIES

All members of the Kurt Masur Academy intensify their orchestral training through a four-semester-long advanced master's studies program (>> Master of Music Orchestral Practice<) at the Carl Maria von Weber College of Music in Dresden. As a rule, their private lessons there are given by musicians of the Dresden Philharmonic. Courses on music physiology, musicology, contract and copyright law, as well as other events to promote their path to a career complement their practice-oriented training program.

»I will never forget how excited I was in my first orchestra rehearsal. By chance, my favorite Tchaikovsky symphony was sitting there on the stand, and I'd never played it. But when it started, all of the tension disappeared. The orchestra and the wonderful music simply »took me with them«, and then it just flowed. I am very grateful for the growth I was able to achieve as a musician and as a human being during my time at the academy.«

>> What impresses me each time is the amazing high level of the young musicians when they come play for us. And their elan. This often makes it difficult to pick the »right one« from the audition. I think it is extremely important that, in addition to honing the orchestral »craft«, they get to know the orchestra as a social structure, because this plays a major role in the daily professional life of a musician. The academy is also an ideal introduction to this.«



MUSIC FOR ALL

That's the aspiration of the Dresden Philharmonic. The orchestra puts on concerts at the highest artistic level, provides musical training for people of all ages, and embodies a vision beyond the musical horizon. Guest appearances on nearly every continent and collaborations with artists from all over the world have firmly placed the Dresden Philharmonic's reputation on the global stage. Since the 2019/2020 concert season, Marek Janowski leads the Dresden Philharmonic as principal conductor and artistic director for the second time.

ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY YEARS

In 1870, the citizens of Dresden took the initiative and inaugurated the history of the Dresden Philharmonic. They gave the Stadtkapelle the chance to hold concerts in the Gewerbehaus and were themselves an attentive audience. In the first few decades, composers such as Brahms, Tchaikovsky, Dvořák and Strauss stood before the orchestra to conduct their own works. In 1934, Paul van Kempen built it into a first-rate ensemble. After him, other world-class conductors, such as Kurt Masur, Marek Janowski, Rafael Frühbeck de Burgos and Michael Sanderling put their stamp on the orchestra.



CONCERT HALL OF DREAMS

In 2017, the Kulturpalast's new concert hall was opened in the middle of the Dresden Altstadt. It has been a boon for the Dresden Philharmonic, for the city and for the entire world of music. Connoisseurs worldwide know it a hidden gem, and Dresden residents themselves also feel at home in its 1,800 coral-red seats.

PHIL_JUNGELEUTE

Exploring classical music with Malte Arkona on a Sunday morning, experiencing the orchestra in the classroom, even being able to try out an instrument – young people and their musical curiosity are important to the Dresden Philharmonic. This dedication is demonstrated by the approximately 35 family and school concerts presented every year, and the partnership with a Dresden elementary school.

LISTENING - ALWAYS AND FOREVER

In 1937, the orchestra began making recordings. Today, the number of works in the Dresden Philharmonic discography stands at nearly 330. Among the newer recordings is a compact disc cycle of the complete symphonies of Dmitri Shostakovich and Ludwig van Beethoven, conducted by Michael Sanderling (Sony Classical). With Marek Janowski, the Dresden Philharmonic has recorded Mascagni's »Cavalleria rusticana«, Puccini's »II Tabarro« and lastly, Beethoven's »Fidelio« (PentaTone).
